

Corrugated Box Fluting

Corrugated Box Fluting refers to the reinforcement that is made up of flute paper, creating a cushion in between pieces of Kraft paper. It provides stacking strength and insulation to protect products.

Sizes of Corrugated Box Fluting

Corrugated box fluting comes in different sizes to be used for different applications. The larger the flute the greater the strength and cushioning. The smaller the flute the better the printability and foldability.


A-Flute: A-Flute is the largest constructed corrugated box flute. Primarily used for a double wall application or a thick corrugated pad.

B-Flute: Primarily used for food packaging, retail packaging, die cut inserts and customized print packaging.

C-Flute: C-Flute is the most commonly used corrugated box flute. Primarily used for shipping cartons, master shippers and box displays.

E-Flute: Primarily used for eco-friendly packaging, retailing packaging and printed box packaging.

F-Flute: F-Flute is the smallest constructed corrugated box flute. This is an environmentally friendly replacement for folding cartons.
